5	Two recent biometric passport sized photographs (3.5x4,5 cm) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Must not be older than 6 months, with bright background and frontal view of the face • Digitally altered passport Photos cannot be accepted • Do not glue or staple the photos to the application form
